### **Our Achievements**

#### **Lake Superior Regional Winners - 2025**

The Tonkabots competed and won the Lake Superior Regional, a week 1 regional event. This qualified us for the World Championship in Houston, TX, where the Tonkabots will travel April 15–20.





#### MN State Champions - 2024

During the 2024 season, Tonkabots qualified for the Minnesota state championship. The Tonkabots went on to win the entire event, becoming the MSHSL State Champions.

#### Northern Lights Regional Winners - 2024

The Tonkabots competed and won the Northern Lights Regional, a week 1 regional event. This qualified us for the World Championship in Houston, TX. At Worlds, the Tonkabots went on to place 22nd out of 75 teams in the Galileo Division.






#### Double DECCer Winners - 2024 & 2025

The Duluth Convention Center hosts two FRC regional events at the same time: Northern Lights Regional and Lake Superior Regional. The Double DECCer is the annual faceoff between the winners of the two regionals... and the Tonkabots triumphed two years in a row!

## Sponsors Enable Us



Tonkabots has a goal to keep a reserve of \$35,000 for if/when we qualify for the World championship. If the team does not qualify for Worlds, the money will be reserved for the most pressing needs of the following season.


